

Samaná officially enters the select club

BREAKING NEWS: - The annual Conference of the Most Beautiful Bays of the World Club was held in Ha Long city in Vietnam, from April the 29th to Sunday May the 2nd. During this event, the bays of Samaná and Rincón were officially certified, making the Dominican Republic the second country in the Caribbean to be recognized by the world organization, sponsored by UNESCO and the UN.

This **conference** gathered representatives from 31 delegations and **bays** around the world, and on this occasion, **Rincón** and **Samaná bays** were officially certified.

Since the public announcement in late 2009 of the acceptance of **Samaná** and **Rincón** Bays into this club, group of institutions, companies and individuals organized into a coordinating team.
